Previous update, Oct 2020.

Here is a brief summary of what has been happening for me over the past few months...



Mid-July: Bone marrow transplant with a two-week hospital stay in an isolated room.

August - Oct: Recovering at home. This was a long, slow process.

Mid-October: Received good news: 'in remission'. Generally feel quite well and continuing with university studies (online). Have regular ongoing appointments with the haematologist
